**FOR ADMISSION TO THE FIRST YEAR OF UNDERGRADUATE ACADEMIC STUDIES OF
ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING AND COMPUTING IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE**

for the academic year 2025/2026 in the fourth enrollment term

The University of Niš, Faculty of Electronic Engineering in Niš (the Faculty, further in the text) admits 27 (twenty seven) self-financed students in the first enrollment term to the first year of undergraduate academic studies of Electrical Engineering and Computing in English in the module Communications and Information Technologies with the following submodules (from the 5th semester):

- Communications and Information Technologies – Communications and Information Processing,
- Communications and Information Technologies – System Engineering and Radio Communications,

for the academic year 2025/2026.

CANDIDATE APPLICATION

The candidates can apply for admission to the first year of undergraduate academic studies of Electrical Engineering and Computing in English if they have graduated from a gymnasium or four-year high school.

Application and submission of documents should be done by sending the documentation on the official e-mail address studyinenglish@elfak.ni.ac.rs in period from **October 13, 2025** till **October 16, 2025**.

ENTRANCE EXAM

Candidates applying for admission to the first year of undergraduate academic studies take the entrance exam in Mathematics in English.

The entrance exam will be taken on **October 21, 2025**, starting at **11 a.m. CEST (GMT+2)**.

The entrance exam should be realized externally, not at the Faculty site, via electronic means of communication, in accordance with the general acts of the Faculty. More details on the web page <https://www.elfak.ni.ac.rs/study-in-english/bachelor-studies/entrance-exam>.

CANDIDATE RANKING

The Faculty determines a preliminary ranking-list of all candidates who meet the criteria for admission based on the overall success in previous education level, regardless of the method of financing.

After the completion of entrance exam, the Faculty will prepare and publish the final ranking list of candidates, as formulated in the admission call. The list is formed on the basis of overall success in higher education and success at entrance exam.

The ranking list is compiled according to the total number of points each candidate receives according to the established criteria. The maximum number of points that each candidate can get during admission procedure is 100 (equals to 100%). Out of 100 points, 60 points (60% of total score) are awarded based on the entrance examination results, while the remaining 40 points (40% of total score) are awarded based on the cumulative grade point average (GPA) from the Secondary/High School.

A candidate can earn from 0 to 60 points on the entrance exam. The candidates are considered to have passed the entrance exam (and thus gained the right to be ranked for enrollment), if they have at least 14 points out of 60 possible.

The general success in Secondary/High School is understood as the sum of the GPA from all subjects with numerical grades in the first, second, third and fourth grades, multiplied by 2 (two). On this basis, a candidate can earn a minimum of 16 and a maximum of 40 points. The GPA and general success in secondary school are calculated according to the rules of rounding to two decimal places.

A candidate may submit a complaint regarding the regularity of the entrance exam and his ranking in the final list to the Commission for Student Admission within 36 hours, and after the Commission's suggestion the Dean puts forward the decision about the complaint within 24 hours of the receipt of the complaint.

The final ranking-list of candidates who passed the exam is formed on the basis of overall success in previous education level and success at the entrance exam. The final ranking list will be published on the Faculty notice board and the Faculty web page.

ACQUISITION OF THE RIGHT TO REGISTRATION

The right to register is granted to a candidate who is ranked in the final ranking-list within the number of students determined by the Call.

FEES

The tuition fee, per year, for the students enrolled for undergraduate academic studies in English in 2025/26 academic year is 3.500 EUR. More information can be seen on the website <https://www.elfak.ni.ac.rs/study-in-english/bachelor-studies/fees>.
